RE: CLASSIFICATIONS - CALENDAR - INVITATION TO HOST IHSMA FESTIVAL

Enclosed are the "Invitation to Host an IHSMA Festival" and the IHSMA classifications for the 2021-2022 school year based upon the preliminary BEDS information recently received in this office. This information MUST be shared with your music staff and activity director in order to coordinate your school calendar for the 2021-2022 school year.

Music festival dates for the 2021-2022 school year are as follows:

October 9/16 All Classes State Marching Band October 20 All Classes All-State Piano Auditions October 23 All Classes All-State Auditions All Classes November 18 - 20 All-State Festival January 24 All Classes (north half) Jazz Band January 29 All Classes (south half) Jazz Band January 31 Show Choir (afternoon/evening) All Classes February 7 All Classes Jazz Choir (afternoon/evening) March 26 Class 3A Solo-Small Ensemble Solo-Small Ensemble April 2 Class 2A Classes 4A/1A April 9 Solo-Small Ensemble Classes 3A/1A May 6 Large Group (evening) Large Group Orchestras in Quad Cities Area May 6 Classes 4A/2A May 7 Classes 4A/2A Large Group

REMINDERS:

- 1. Member schools may participate in the next larger classification by submitting a letter of request bearing the signature of the music staff and a high school administrator. Submit this letter <u>prior to May 30</u> so planning for the upcoming year can be completed accurately prior to summer vacation.
- 2. IMPORTANT: Schools not in session the week prior or the week following the assigned IHSMA Solo/Small Ensemble Festival date may petition the IHSMA to participate on one of the other 2 IHSMA Solo/Small Ensemble Festival dates. All petitions must be signed by the school's administration and submitted no later than May 30. Accepted petitions will be grouped by classification when reasonable groupings exist; otherwise schools will be grouped with schools from the next higher or lower classification. 4A schools petitioning to participate on the Class 2A date will NOT be grouped with Class 2A schools. There must be enough Class 4A schools (3 or more within a reasonable geographic distance) requesting the Class 2A date to create a separate Class 4A festival grouping.

Class 4A = 600+ students in grades 9-11
Class 3A = 275 - 599 students in grades 9-11
Class 2A = 150 - 274 students in grades 9-11
Class 1A = 149 or less students in grades 9-11

2020-2021 has been an extremely challenging year but a year of outstanding high school music performances and participation as well as a year of great challenge and perseverance. Thank you for your efforts in enriching the lives of lowa students.
