Friday, November 18, 2022

- Buses are to drop off and pick up in Lot F – west of Stephens. The fire lane can be used for loading/unloading but parking in this lot will not be available.
- Parking is available in the Iowa State Center lots on **Friday only**.
- Friday night, ALL lots will be cleared out after midnight. This includes lots north of Scheman. If cars are left overnight, they will be towed.

Saturday, November 19, 2022

- No parking is allowed in the Iowa State Center lots from midnight – 6:05 p.m. (see attached map)
- Buses/school vehicles are to drop off and pick up in Lot F – west of Stephens. The fire lane can be used for loading/unloading but parking in this lot will not be available.
- Buses/school vehicles should park in parking lot #63 across on north side of Lincoln Way, next to the Maple Willow Larch residence hall.
- All-State Music participants can stage between their closed rehearsal and festival in Scheman (Lobby 1) until 7:00 p.m. Festival students need to be in their seat at Hilton by 7:00 p.m. and festival students will enter using lower West doors at Hilton.

ALL-STATE MUSIC SPECTATORS (see attached spectator map)

Saturday, November 19, 2022

- No parking is allowed in the Iowa State Center lots on Saturday from midnight – 6:05 p.m.
- We expect All-State spectators to arrive later (**after 6:05 p.m.**) rather than sooner. We anticipate heavy game day traffic between 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Everyone is encouraged to carpool to maximize parking.
- **After 6:05 p.m.** any available spot in the Iowa State Center lots is first come, first serve. After 6:05 p.m. gameday parking restrictions will be lifted and parking will be available in any of the Iowa State Center lots surrounding Hilton Coliseum.
- Additional lots on campus are available prior to 6:05 p.m. (see map)
- An All-State Music spectator shuttle will be running from 5:40 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. between parking lot #63 and East Parking Deck with drop off at Hilton Coliseum. After the concert a shuttle will be provided from 9:30 p.m. – 11:00 p.m. (please come to the lower west entrance at Hilton) to Lot 63 & East Parking Deck. Please note in order to be able to navigate the parking lots/traffic this is a CIT mini-bus which seats 14 pax at a time, so the loop may take longer than expected and people may need to wait due to traffic. If you are able to walk, please leave the shuttle to those that may need the assistance.
- All-State Music doors open to the public at 6:30 p.m. at Hilton Coliseum. General public entrance is located at the south entrance of Hilton Coliseum.
- Please note that anticipated heavy traffic is anticipated around the Iowa State Center parking lots when football game ends, and All-State Music concert concludes (approx. 9:15 – 9:45 p.m.). Leave time from the parking lots will take longer than normal.

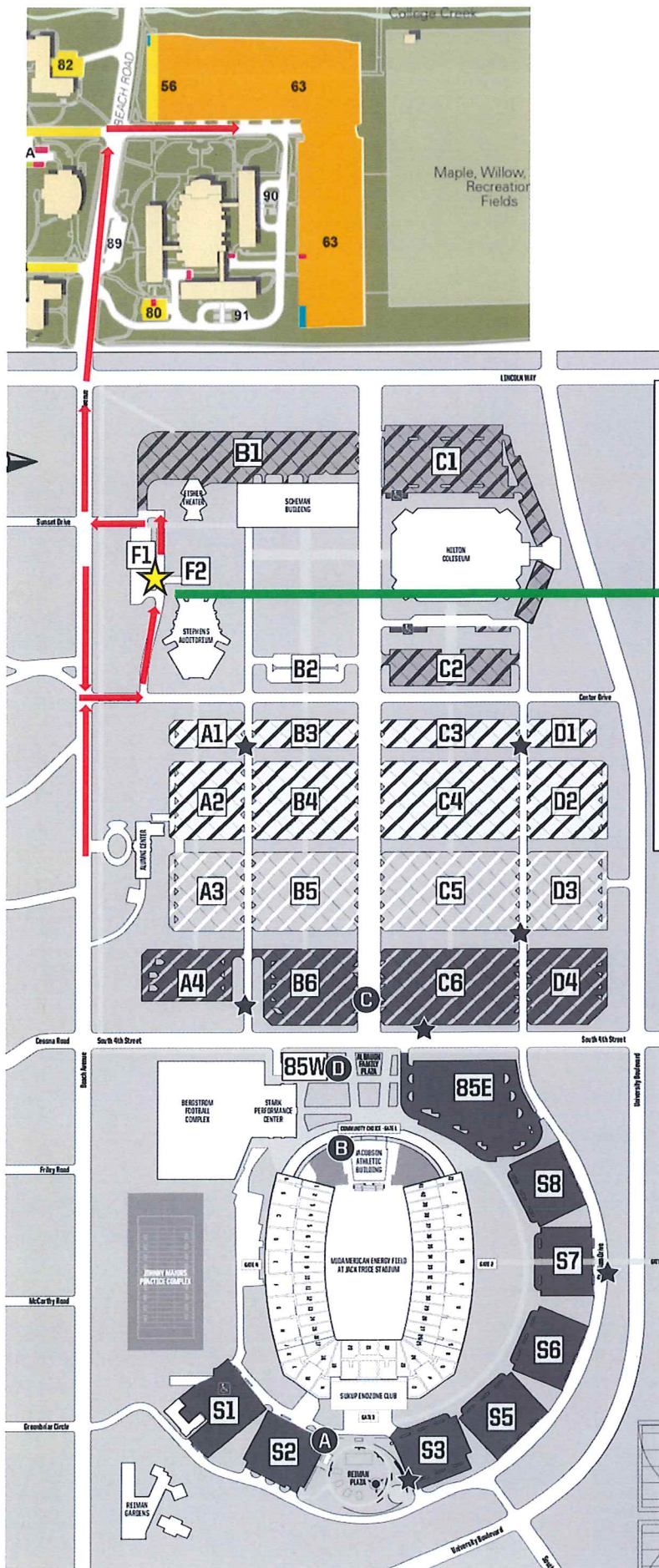

After 6:05 p.m. it is permitted to drop off spectators on the south side of Hilton Coliseum prior to finding parking (i.e. those with limitations, etc.).

Prior to 6:05 p.m., Center Drive will be CLOSED to thru traffic.
