Outstanding Performer's Showcase

The Iowa Choral Director's Association founded the Outstanding Performer's Showcase in 1989. In 1990 the Iowa Bandmasters Association held its first Outstanding Performer's Recital. Originally designed as separate events, they were combined in 2003 for the convenience of schools participating. This showcase was established to celebrate the accomplishments of students selected as "Outstanding Performances" at the IHSMA State Solo-Small Ensemble Festival.

ICDA Scholarship

The Iowa Choral Directors Association will award a \$1,000 scholarship to the top senior vocal soloist performing at the Outstanding Performers Showcase.

Solo performances are recorded and judged at a later date. The top vocal performance is awarded the scholarship.

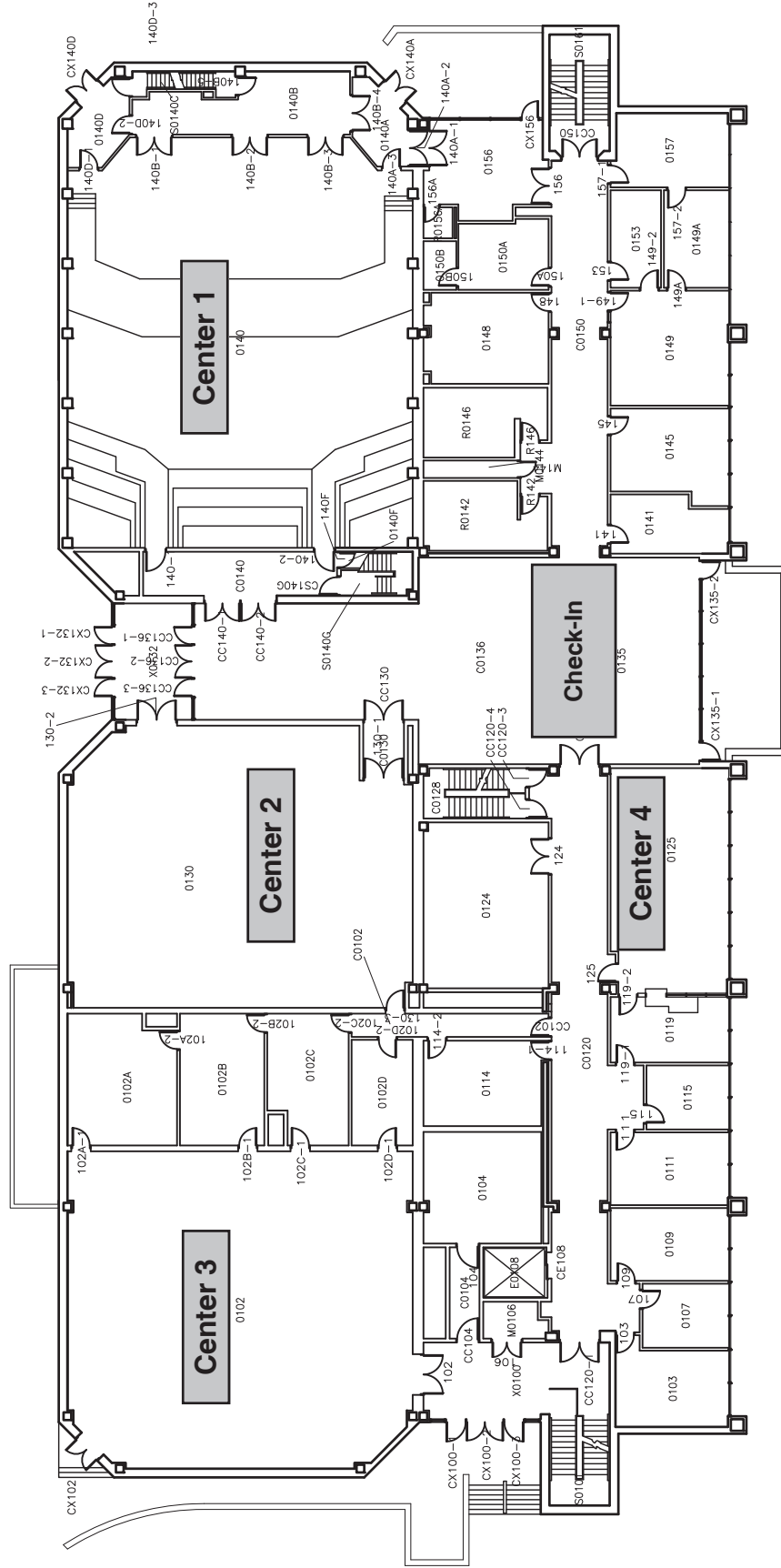
